



Spurr Soil Probe – Dig Stick

A simple to use tool for the evaluation of soil profile for root depth and moisture etc. Maximum depth 850mm

Operating and Care Instructions

CAUTION: Sharp Edges – Use gloves when handling.
For urban use, check for underground services.

1. Locate the 'Dig Stick' near source of irrigation (i.e. within 15-30cm from dripper).
2. Insert handle and push 'Dig Stick' into soil as far as possible.
3. If further depth is required, remove handle, then use a lightweight club hammer (4lb) and hammer into required depth. Recommend a 'Spurr Drive Cap' for this purpose and for OH&S requirements.
4. Insert handle, twist 360° and withdraw gradually.

NOTE: OH&S Precautions when lifting
– Bend your knees!

5. Inspect soil core for your requirements.
6. Remove handle, place thick bevelled end into top of channel and slide carefully (warning sharp edges!) down channel to remove soil.
7. Clean the dig stick with a stiff brush and water (note: to prevent rusting, suggest spray with rustproof lubricant after use).
8. For extended life, please treat with respect.
